

Access Statement For The Waterford Southport

Introduction

We aim to cater for the needs of all visitors to our 8 bedroom bed and breakfast accommodation. The following statement is a summary of our provision. If you have any specific questions please feel free to call us and we will endeavour to help.

Pre-Arrival

- There is a bus stop on Lord Street and there is a frequent bus service
- The main train station is 5 minutes away by car.
- There is a local taxi service that has accessible taxis if required
- Menus can be provided in large print by prior arrangement, Assistance is always available in the dining room
- You can contact us via telephone or email.

Arrival & Car Parking Facilities

- On Arrival to the property there is an open entrance.
- There are marked parking bays and there is ample room for 6 cars and two further spaces at the rear of the Waterford
- The surface is level tarmac and relatively flat.
- We can assist guests with luggage
- Lord Street is a few minutes' walk from The Waterford

Main Entrance & Reception

- The front entrance has four steps 23cm high and is too steep for a ramp.
- There is a round stainless steel grab rail each side of the steps.
- The front door is to the left hand side and opens outwards, it is always locked. The door bell is to the right.
- On entry there is a wide hallway and a sun lounge to either side. 3 metres on there is a second door. This door opens inwards and is usually locked. There is a bell to the left
- There is seating provided in the hallway

Public Areas - General (Internal)

- All ground floor doorways are at least 80cm wide
- Corridors have a good colour contrast and are well lit
- The flooring on all corridors on the ground floor is short pile carpet
- The covering on stairs and upstairs corridors is short pile carpet
- Dog water bowl and food bowl (and food if requested in advance) are available on request

Public Areas - WC

There are no ground floor or public toilets available

Dining Room Bar & Lounges,

- The breakfast room, bar and lounge are on the ground floor.
- Breakfast is served in the dining room on the ground floor. There are no steps but the floor is slightly uneven
- Furniture is flexible and can be moved on request.
- Tables are round (85cm in diameter) and have one central leg.(73cm high, 68cm under space).
The dining chairs have arms.
- Menus can provided in large print by prior arrangement

Bedrooms

- All bedrooms are situated on the first and second floors.
There is no lift.

- There are 14 stairs to a landing followed by a further 6 stairs to the first floor.

- The stairs are 18cm high, 29cm deep, and 82cm wide.

- There is a 70cm wide fire door at the top of the stairs.

- Bedroom doors are 76cm wide, bathroom doors are 60cm wide.

- Most rooms can be configured as either a double bedded room or a twin bedded room

- At least 60cm routes within the bedroom e.g. to the side of beds, between beds and dressing table, therefore allowing for left or right transfer to beds in any combination

- Furniture is moveable on request

- Beds are 60cm high but can be raised with blocks on request in advance.

- Television with remote control and teletext

- Divan beds are provided

- Two armchairs, or one armchair and one upright chair (no arms) are provided in the room

- All rooms are en-suite.

- Fitted short pile carpet on the bedroom floor

Bathrooms [Ensuite]

- Anti slip vinyl is fitted in the bathrooms.
- The bath has a shower attachment fitted above, and a hinged glass shower screen.
- A bath seat is available.
- The basin is rounded at the front and has a pedestal. It is 86cm high.
- The toilet is 46cm high
- The bathrooms are fully tiled in white with white fittings.
- Good colour contrast of floors and walls.
- Door width 76cm wide opening inwards.
- Free floor space 95cm x 170cm

Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcomed.
- Mobile phone reception is generally good
- We are able to use the front and back doors in the need of evacuation.
- The fire alarm rings continuously if evacuation is needed. Each bedroom is fitted with a detector, sounder and strobe light (hearing impairment).
- If you will require assistance for evacuating please notify us on arrival and we will ensure you are evacuated safely.

- We are a no smoking building.
- We supply a small drinks fridge in the bedrooms which

can be used for medication/food and we can put larger items in our main fridge on request (not available 24hours).

Future Plans

- We are constantly redesigning and upgrading The Waterford. Each room is different in size and layout, we have tried to describe an average bedroom and en-suite bathroom layout. The details outlined are not definitive. We strongly advise that you inform us any special requirements you have, prior to booking.
